CITY CENTRE

*From Place de la Liberté, follow the tramway tracks
along the famous Rue de Siam between cafés, shops
and fountains. The end of this pedestrian street is
a key spot, a theatre overlooking the military port
as well as a springboard to «Recouvrance» historic
district.*

which bears witness to the great
naval adventure.
Outside sections of the visit offer
a magnificent scenic view of Brest
harbour and city.

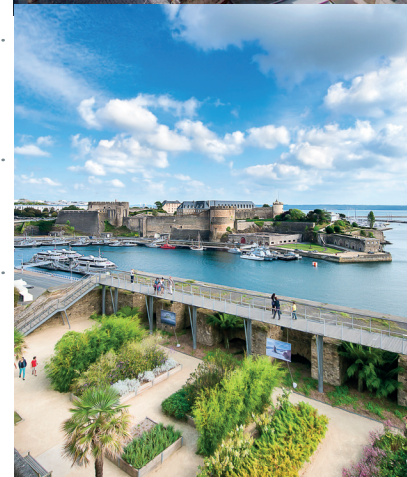

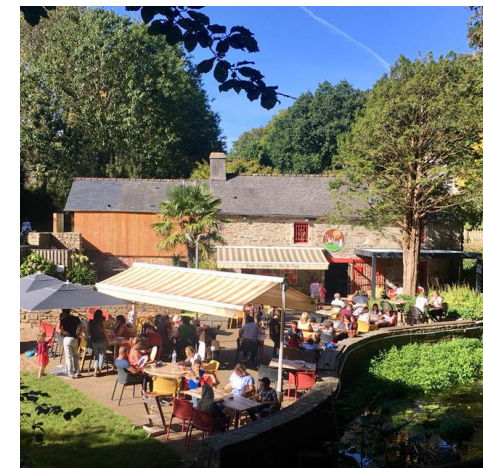
The garden

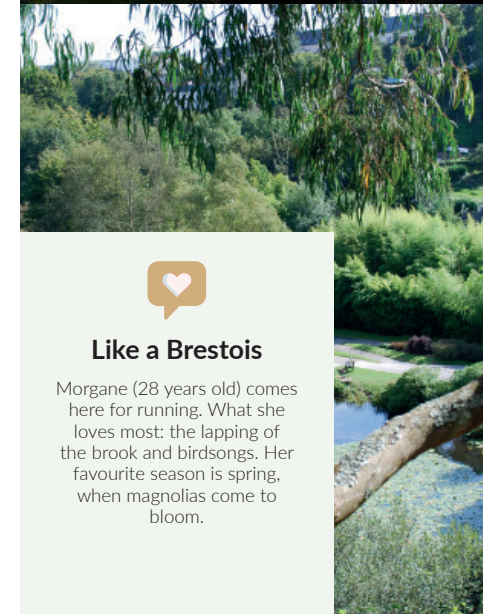
