

SAINT-MATHIEU LIGHTHOUSE IN PLOUGONVELIN

Inoise figurehead

The red and white tower stands near the spectacular ruins of the Benedictine abbey. From the walkway of this historical monument, you'll have a perfect view on the archipelago of Molène, the island of Ouessant, the Pierres Noires Causeway and the Pointe du Raz. Light up your way! 

FORTIFIED ISLAND OF BERTHEAUME IN PLOUGONVELIN

Built by Vauban in the 17th century to watch over the port of Brest and integrated into the Atlantic Wall during the Second World War, the fort offers guided tours, storytelling walks, and for the more courageous, an adventure course with a zip-line. Visit the fort during the summer, you'll have an unobstructed view of Brest' harbor.

KERMORVAN LIGHTHOUSE IN LE CONQUET

The most western of France!

Lined up with Lochrist, Trezien and Saint-Mathieu lighthouses, Kermorvan lighthouse overlooks the Iroise Sea from its own peninsula. It was lightened for the first time in 1849, and it's the most westerly of mainland France! With its magical setting and breathtaking views, the costal path leading to the lighthouse is a delight for hikers and strollers.


Renowned for its former pink granite quarries, this "Breton fjord" emerges into the Iroise Sea at the entrance of the Four Channel. Even though it's the smallest of Finistère's tideways, it's Europe's leading seaweed port! During the summer, boats set sail for the islands of Molène and Ouessant from its port.



MELON ISLAND

Porspoder is, by far, the richest in terms of megaliths in the whole Iroise, and it's on this islet that they are more numerous despite destruction. There is no less than 4 menhirs, 1 burial mound, 2 cairns and 5 dolmens in this small area. The largest menhir, reaching around seven metres, was blown up by the Germans in 1942.

The island is only reachable on foot **at low tide.** Check the tide times, don't linger on the islet and keep an eye on the rising tide.



Built in 11 years, the lighthouse has witnessed tragedy. Along with the Pierres Noires lighthouse, they were the first to have a conical shape for better stability. Qualified as "hell" by its keepers, it guides sailors at the crossing of the Iroise Sea and the Channel since 14 March 1874! Battered by swell during storms, it's a lovely sight from our shorelines.

Before continuing your journey on the lighthouses route, enjoy the endless Trois Moutons beach. From this white-sand beach, you can see the largest lighthouse in all of Europe watching over the Channel: the lle Vierge lighthouse. Easily accessible by all, this beach will be a delight for large natural area lovers. It is also a paradise for the kitesurf due to its gentle and wild slope.



"Once upon a time, there was a castle on the island of Carn. In this castle lived a Lord Karn who used to bring people from the continent to shave him and cut his hair. However, none of them ever returned. Until one day, a brave young man named Losthouarn decided to become the next barber. He noticed that the lord had horse ears and quickly understood that the previous barbers had been killed to keep this secret. With a swift and decisive stroke of his razor, he slit the lord's throat and returned home unharmed."

The only way to reach this island and discover its cairn – a megalith with three burial chambers from 6000 years before J.C. – is at low tide (coefficient 80) and with a 15-minutes walk. Look the tide times up.

SAINT-MATHIEU

On this rocky overhang, take in 1,000 years of history by visiting Saint-Mathieu lighthouse, Fine-Terre abbey, Saint-Mathieu abbey museum, and the National Memorial to sailors who died for France. The preserved heritage and views of the Natural Marine Park of Iroise and its islands make this a unique, almost magical site in Finistère.

The memory lane for the sailors around the pointe Saint-Mathieu (a 2-mile loop) has stops, where the names of the boats and their crews that disappeared during battles, storms, and other events are written on granite blocks.

At night, Saint-Mathieu turns on its beam of 31-mile range to guide the incoming ships. During summer, the classic "Lighthouse nights" offer a unique experience: to be on top of a lighthouse at the nearest of its beam to view the sentinels of the sea lightened. Check out our calendar!

39-45 MEMORIES MUSEUM

Near the Pointe Saint-Mathieu, travel back in time in this extraordinary German command blockhouse. On 5 floors, discover a museography centered on testimonies and stories illustrated by thousands of objects, evidence, and photographs. Going down in the fortress, you'll start to dive into the daily life of soldiers of the Atlantic Wall.

Going through the thematic galleries, you'll relive the war history of Brittany, told by those who lived it. At the end of your visit, enjoy the panoramic view from the observation post and the roof of the blockhouse, over the entrance to the Brest roadstead, from the Crozon peninsula to the island of Ouessant.



Moored in Le Conquet, the fishing boat Kervouroc is a drifter. In their premises settled at 10 Street Paul Cong in Le Conquet, Yannick and Laïs sell all year round on Wednesday and Saturday mornings from 9:00am to 11:00am. The boat only goes to sea when the coefficient is below 80, that is in average one week out of two throughout the year. The main products that they sell are monkfishes, pollacks, ray wings, crabs, spider crabs, and lobsters. It may vary according to the day's catch.

THE ABER OF LE **CONQUET**

A VAST SALT MARSH, THE MIGRATORY **BIRD PARADISE**

In autumn, winter, and spring, numerous migratory birds make a stopover here: it's a perfect shelter from prevailing winds. There observation posts along an ornithological course. Be discreet and keep your eyes open! Eurasian curlew, Eurasian spoonbill, grey heron, ruddy turnstone, redshanks. Eurasian ovstercatcher. common shelduck, and other sandpipers are nesting or visiting the aber throughout the seasons.



NOTRE-DAME DU VAL CHAPEL IN TRÉBABU

Hidden deep in its vale, Notre-Dame du Val chapel has a rather unusual statue of the Virgin Mary holding a fig in her right hand. Stolen in 1977, the statue was found 28 years later in a church in Solliès-Pont, a town in the south of France, which is the capital of fig. Nearby, a small pond has miraculous water that should heal children suffering from stuttering and other speech impediments. During summer, the association "Eglises et chapelles en Iroise" does concerts in the chapel.


LES BLANCS SABLONS, A WONDERFUL **PLAYGROUND!**

Facing the Ponant islands, it has an incredible view of the coast, stretching from Saint-Mathieu headland in the south to the headlands of Illien and Corsen in the north.





THE INHABITANTS THANKED BY THE QUEEN OF ENGLAND

In June 1896, the English liner "Drummond Castle" sank off the coast of Molène. Only 3 out of 250 passengers were rescued. Queen Victoria thanked Molène and its inhabitants with various gifts, as well as the building of an impluvium and a clock for the church bell tower.

A new scenography dedicated to this tragedy, which marked the island's history, is displayed in the town hall courtyard during Easter holidays, weekends in June, and summer holidays.

PROTECTED SPECIES.

Molène archipelago is one of the last places safe for many species. Here, they have the right conditions for breeding, resting, and feeding. All the uninhabited islands and islets of the archipelago and their foreshores are classified in the Iroise National Nature Reserve. Access and movement on the islands, as well as the activities, are regulated in order to preserve the species and the environment.

Marine birds like the common ringed plover or the European storm petrel are being studied here:



Of the 200 nester pairs in France, 40 to 50 pairs live in the Molène archipelago. The common ringed plover is considered "vulnerable" and listed as a rare and endangered nester in France.



Dating back some 4,000 years, the Kerloas menhir, and its 9,50 metres, is the highest megalith currently standing! It lies in the countryside between Plouarzel and Saint-Renan. Its peak was struck by lightning.

IN PLOUARZEL

A LEGENDARY LOCATION

Once upon a time, newlyweds came naked to rub their bellies against the bumps of the menhir, the wife on one side, the husband on the other. The man was certain of having male offspring, the woman of ruling her husband as she pleased.



The legend also tells of a hidden treasure, visible only on Christmas Eve. The legend says that at the first stroke of midnight, the menhirs ran to the ocean to drink. But by the time the twelfth stroke sounded, they were already back in their place, stoic, immobile, impervious to the ravages of time. And woe betide the unwary who, dazzled by the unveiled riches, had forgotten the hour; they were crushed.



CHAPEL

IN PLOUMOGUER

This bucolic chapel, known as the "shipwrecked" church, is a jewel of sacred art. If you wish to find it, continue your journey along the GR®34 to the north from the cliff of Brenterc'h and walk 500 m to a large staircase.



AROUND THE ABER ILDUT

The Aber Ildut is a haven of peace in direct touch with the Iroise Sea. At the end of the 18th century, twice as many merchant ships were fitted out here as in Brest. Nowadays, the harbour welcomes the pleasure sailors, the goémoniers, and the shipping companies, which do the crossings to Molène and Ouessant.

The hiking trail "Along the Aber Ildut" takes you around the Aber Ildut river. Along the way, you'll discover the Seaweed House, the maritime heritage of the aber, the Kerglonou site and its granite quarries, the Pont Rheun, the Bel Air manor, the heritage of La Franchise, and granite townhouses.

Go kayaking in a bay sheltered from the wind and the swell. You'll be able to enjoy the riches of the Aber Ildut, its flora and fauna, as well as its history.





ANCRE AN EOR - IN THE WAKE OF THE AMOCO CADIZ

"The worst part was the silence. We couldn't hear the sea or the birds" Alphonse Arzel, former senator-mayor of Ploudalmézeau

16 March 1978: the Amoco Cadiz sank off the coast of Portsall and discharged 227 000 tonnes of oil at sea along the 223 miles of coastline. Outcome: tens of thousands of birds were oil-covered, 30% of the fauna and 5% of the flora were destroyed over an area of 1,300 square kilometres, the economic death of a part of the region. It's "the oil slick of the 20th century."

The museum space "In the wake of the Amoco Cadiz" recalls the circumstances of this catastrophe, the strong mobilisation, the consequence, and the fight of the elected representatives. Discover the measures implemented after this dreadful oil slick, especially the adjustment of the Ouessant rail and the application of the Polluter Pays Principle.

This museum is also a place of pilgrimage for many who remember the era that left a mark in people's minds

The anchor, a true symbol of this tragedy, is displayed on the port. It points at the dangerous area where the Amoco sank.



POTTED FISH WITH SEA BEANS

270 g of fish fillets (sardine, mackerel, etc), ideally fresh or from a can, 1 tablespoon of finely chopped parsley (or sea parsley), 1 finely chopped shallot, 40 g of cooked sea beans, 20 g of butter, a squeeze of lemon, salt, pepper, and spices according to taste.

Remove the fish bones and oil, then mash it with a fork to obtain a smooth paste. Add all the ingredients and mix it. You can replace the butter with a soft cheese. Finish by adding sea beans.

Serve on toasts as an appetiser. Bon appétit!

Don't leave Iroise without trying our local dish: the kig ha farz, literally "meat and far" in Breton.

This pot-au-feu from Léon consists of vegetables, meat, black and white "farz" cooked in cloth bags. It is simmered for at least two hours, and served with a delicious sauce of salted butter and shallots called "lipig." And since seafood is a staple of our local cuisine, some restaurants serve an other option: the pesk ha farz, the kig ha farz from the sea! Ask your tourist office for the recipe and the restaurants to eat it!






