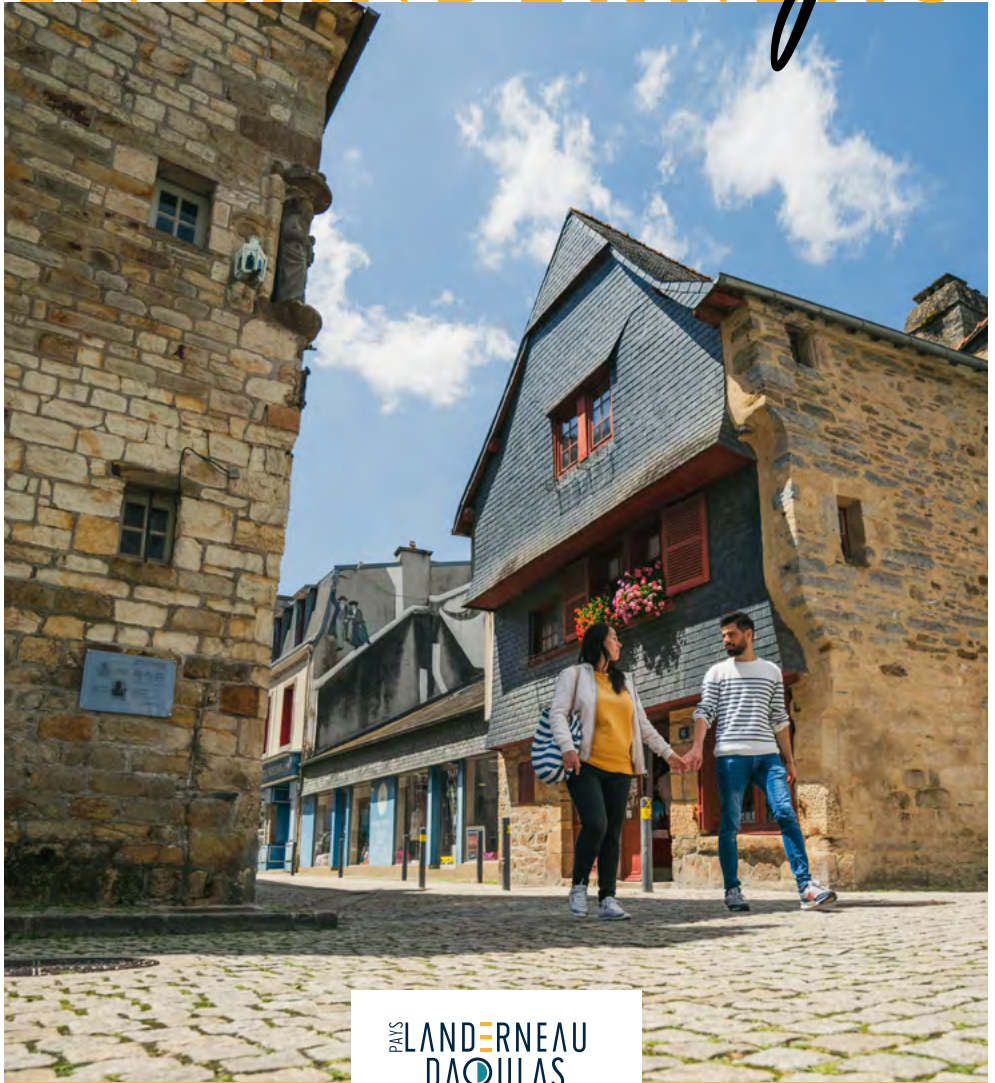

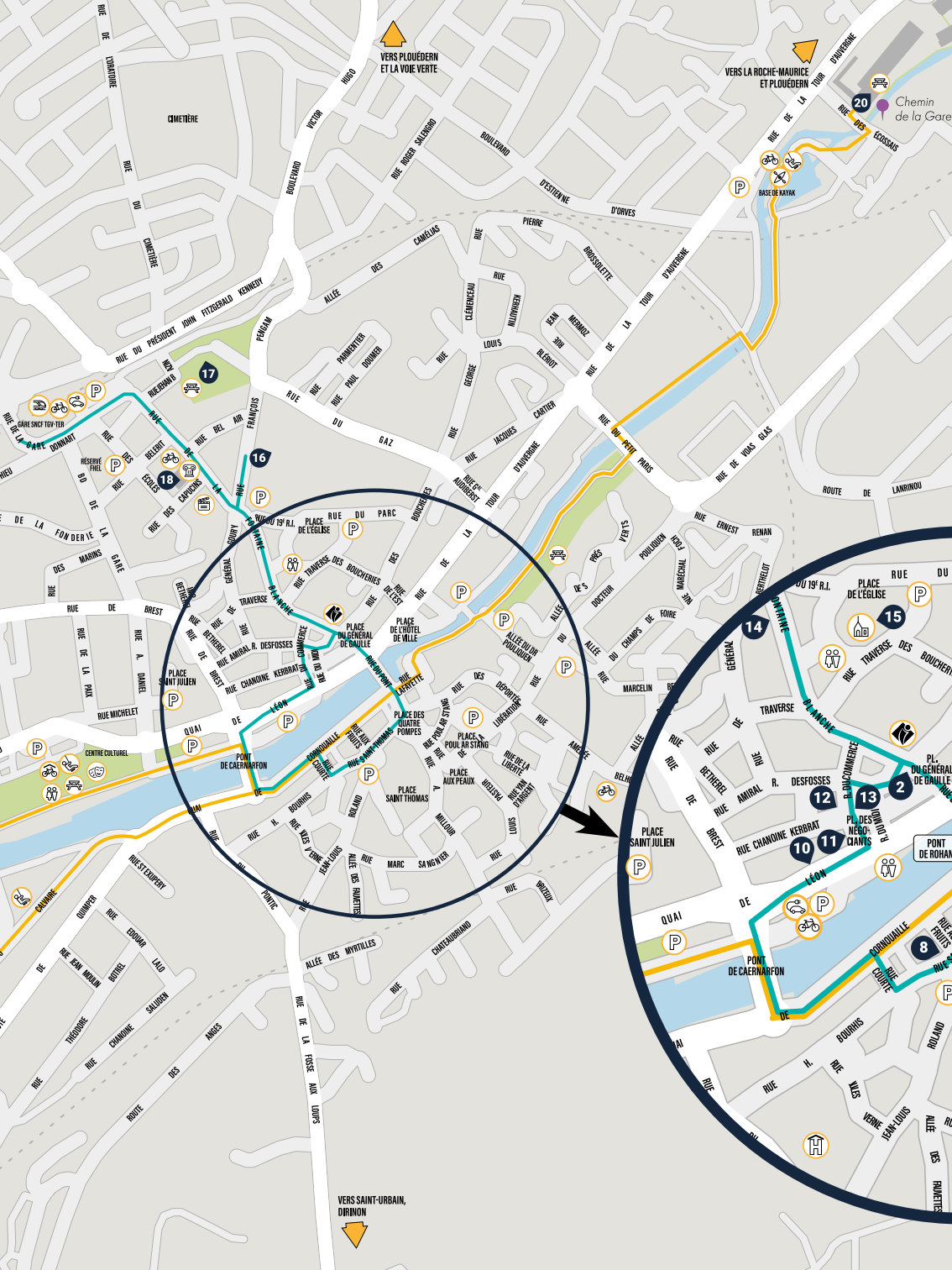


### By train

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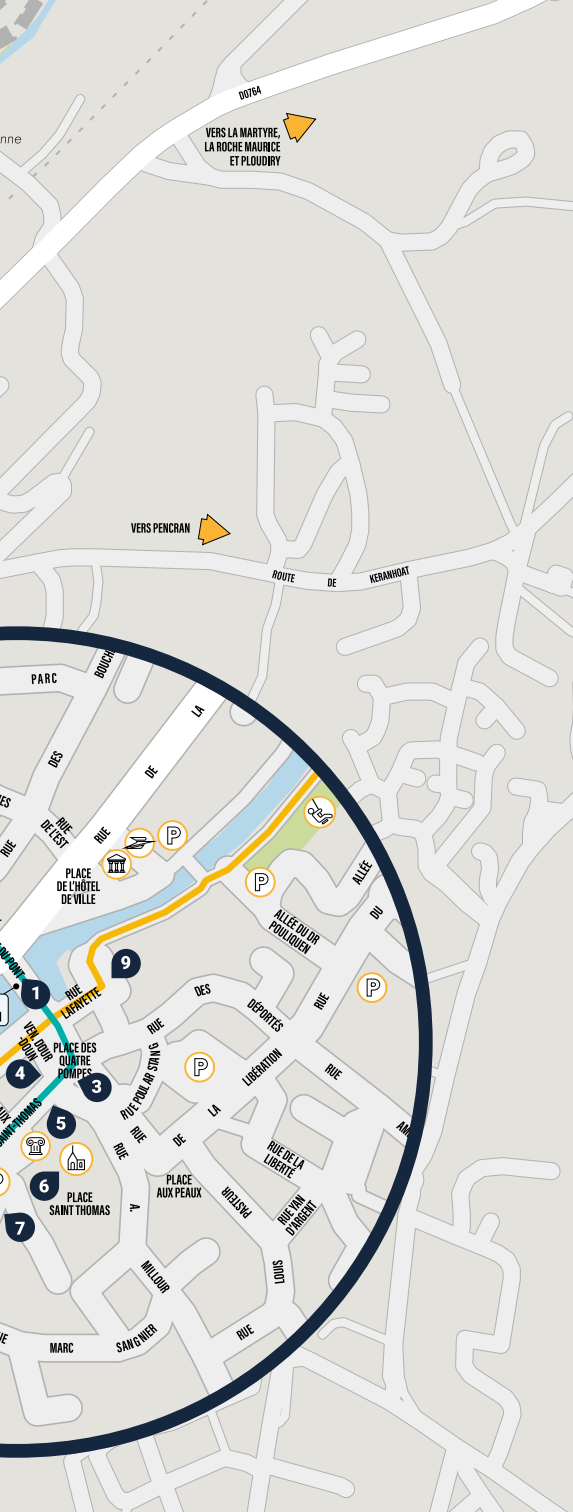

# A COLOURFUL history

Are you a history buff, a lover of fine stonework or just naturally curious? Head to the heart of Landerneau to discover the secrets of its heritage treasures!

## In the footsteps of...



### PONT DE ROHAN

For over 500 years, the Pont de Rohan has sat proudly at the heart of the town. Bustling with cafés and shops, **it is one of the last inhabited bridges in Europe!**

### MAISON DE LA SÉNÉCHAUSSÉE

Built in 1664, the Maison de la Sénéchaussée, known as the Maison de la Duchesse Anne, stands on the place Général de Gaulle. Push open the door: **the building houses a creperie and a tearoom.**

### THE HOMES OF SHIPOWNERS AND MERCHANTS

For a long time, Landerneau was one of Brittany's major ports thanks to its linen and wine trade. Along the wharfs, **discover the rich homes of merchants and shipowners.**

### THE CHURCHES OF SAINT-THOMAS AND SAINT-HOUARDON

To each his own church! In Landerneau **two churches sit proudly in the heart of the town**, one in Léon (to the north) and the other in Cornouaille (to the south).

### GRANDE BRIQUETERIE

A testament to the town's industrial history, the Grande Briqueterie is **the cradle of two historic industries: flax and brick.** Discover its history at the permanent exhibit!

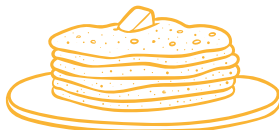

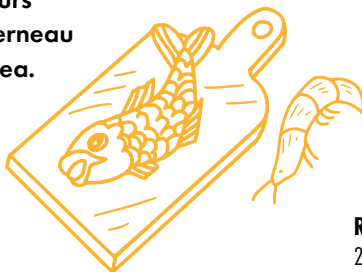

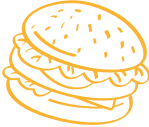

Landerneau is also a great place to enjoy nature! For an afternoon, follow the banks of the Élorñ River and its towpath to discover another side of the town.



## A breath of fresh air!



### CHEMIN DES BERGES

Along this route, from the Pont Levant to the Grande Briqueterie, **you'll see the banks of the Élorñ**. As you walk along the river, you'll discover not only Landerneau's heritage, but also a varied and well-preserved biodiversity. You can shorten your walk at any time, thanks to the bridges and foot-bridges that span the Élorñ.

**6.5 km - 2 hr/Easy**



### GO FURTHER

Extend your Élorñ experience, **the route continues towards La Roche-Maurice on one side and La Forest-Landerneau on the other**. Two atmospheres around the same river to discover on foot or by bike (building underway).

### EVEN MORE HIKING!

Go further and discover Landerneau and its surrounding countryside by following **one of our three marked walking trails**. At your own pace, take the time to observe, listen, and enjoy the magnificent viewpoints and unearth little heritage treasures.

**Le Chemin de la Garenne** 6.8 km - 1 hr 30/Moderate

**Le Chemin de Saint-Ernel** 5.9 km - 1 hr 30/Moderate
