






By train





CLIMB TO NEW HEIGHTS!

Gain some height in the Monts d'Arrée. At the top of Roc'h an Daol, reaching 298 m high, you can enjoy a 360° view over the Ménez Hom to the south-west, Brest harbour to the west and the Monts d'Arrée to the northeast. A dream photo spot!

TAKE A BREATH

Here, the "country" spirit is expressed in a wide range of atmospheres! Between the barrens, peat bogs, rocky outcrops and forests, the unspoilt countryside invites you slow down even more.



DOMAINE DE MENEZ MEUR

The Domaine de Menez Meur unites the unique landscapes of the Monts d'Arrée with its breathtaking scenery and views of the barrens and forests. Animals lovers will be right at home. Menez Meur is a conservatory of Breton breeds: Ouessant sheep, western white pigs, and black and white Breton cows. There are also wild species such as deer and even wolves!

Join us for a workshop and discover the domestic and wildlife of Brittany. Birdwatching, discovering farm animals, wolf watching... Our guides will facilitate an unforgettable experience for all ages!

BETWEEN THE BARRENS AND PEAT BOGS

Unique in Brittany, the Langazel wetland in Trémaouézan is home to the oldest peat bog in the region and boasts some remarkable plants and wildlife. Start from the Trémaouézan school and take the hiking trail to discover its rich biodiversity. Want to find out more? Follow the interpretative trail.





3, 2, 1, CLIMB!

Take in the sights at Roc'h an Daol, Saint-Eloy. A trail loop guides you to the highest point (298 m), where a 360° view awaits you over the Ménez-Hom, Brest harbour, and the Monts d'Arrée mountain range. The jutting rocks, ferns, gorse, and heather of the surrounding area will seduce you.

LET'S TAKE A WALK IN THE WOODS!

In Hanvec, follow the many footpaths through the Cranou state forest. Ideal for hiking, the GR37 crosses the forest. It is one of the wettest forests in Brittany, which explains its botanical richness. Let the enchanting atmosphere envelop you!



CHÂTEAU DE ROC'H MORVAN

Overlooking the Élorn Valley on its rocky outcrop, Roc'h Morvan castle has been perched 70 metres high since the 11th century. From the fortress, enjoy an exceptional panoramic view of the Élorn Valley. A exciting step back in time!

THE LEGEND OF "The Dragon of Roc'h Morvan"

Élorn, lord of the Roche-Maurice, was distressed to learn that his son had just been chosen as a sacrifice for the dragon that had been devastating the country. Consumed by his grief, the lord threw himself into the river, but Derrien saved him from drowning and set off to slay the horrible beast. He ordered the dragon to come out of his lair and throw himself into the sea at Pontusval (Brignogan). Since then, the river has carried Élorn's name.



PARISH ENCLOSURES IN THE ÉLORN VALLEY

Explore the parish enclosures lining Élorn Valley. The enclosures, a unique heritage in Europe, bear witness to a people's fervour and the region's wealth. In the 16th and 17th centuries, flax was spun, woven, and exported throughout Europe. The religious heritage has been updated, and churches have been adorned with enclosures to illustrate their richness.

What's an enclosure?

It can be identified by a number of architectural features: a church, an entrance porch, a calvary, an ossuary, and a cemetery, all surrounded by a perimeter wall and a triumphal gate. These sacred spaces filled religious and social functions: the parish enclosure serves as a catechism for parishioners. The calvaries, walls, statues, and stained glass windows tell the story of the saints and Christ, as well as Breton legends.

OUR TREASURES

- La Martyre: welcome to the oldest parish enclosure in Leon! Altered several times over the centuries, it is considered to be a condensed version of Brittany's religious architectural history.
- Roche Maurice: look up! Its bell tower is said to be one of the most beautiful in the Léon region. Discover the large Passion window, the second-largest stained glass window in Brittany.
- · Ploudiry: until the Revolution, Ploudiry was the largest and richest parish in the Léon region. This explains the sumptuousness of its enclosure and monumental porch.

Discover the enclosures at Pencran, Dirinon, Tréflévénez, Trémaouézan... and many more! Our Top Tip: follow the enclosure discovery trail (see map).
